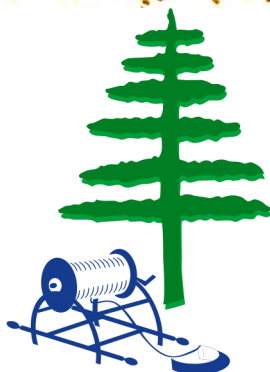

Some words on Jeff Rolls from long-time friend and TBSLSC Life Member Peter Cox:

Toowoon Bay SLSC Early Days with Jeff Rolls

When Bob Roberts began to push to form a surf club at Toowoon Bay he talked to all the young locals who swam at the beach so he had an enthusiastic group ready to go when the inaugural meeting was held and Jeff was among that group. The six-week Christmas holidays saw the beach packed with holiday makers and plenty of locals for the rest of the season. Bronze squads were formed and Jeff and those early members soon became fully qualified patrol members. Surf Club became a way of life for club duties, socialising, surfing, fund raising and everything else. Jeff used his mentoring skills to train bronze squads and later as a member of the Board of Examiners continuing this right across the coast. He was a keen long boarder, and a strong body surfer and we spent much time out surfing the point, over the reef and at North Shelly honing the skills that helped keep people safe in the water. Old habits die hard and Jeff was able to make a very important rescue as an octogenarian. Of course, there were girls at the beach and many long marriages came from this. Jeff met Lyn somewhere around the Club and they made a lifetime together. At first, we were all shocked to think that Jeff had passed away in the water, but on reflection it seems to have been a peaceful and easy passing which many of us would hope for. Farewell old friend.



And in June we lost Kevin Bootle. Kevin was a great competitor for Toowoon Bay on boards and in surfboats until he transferred to Avoca SLSC. Kevin remained very active in the Surf Boat Series (Peters and Streets) until illness prevented him from attending his beloved boat carnivals. Kevin was highly regarded and respected in the movement.

President's Report - 2020/2021

It is with pleasure that I submit this report. All members should be enormously proud of their efforts this year and it just shows what a great community club we are.

If we thought the previous year was different, well what about this one? Torrential rain, floods, 40 plus degree days, hordes of tourists and of course the ever-present COVID 19.

The 2020/2021 season started with us not knowing if we would be able to patrol the beach and, if we could, what restrictions would be placed on members or patrols. Then there were the constant issues and changes on how, or if, our Nippers programs could go ahead. The whole scenario was changing weekly, frustratingly, and planning a program was becoming increasingly difficult. COVID restrictions also had a massive impact on our social events including our Awards of Excellence (senior presentation), Sunday SIPS, The Captain's Shout, and the management of our Café.

With all the uncertainty caused by the pandemic, member and community safety, it was expected that our member numbers would be decimated at the start of the season. Fortunately, around 88% of our active patrolling members returned to patrolling duties. Our Nippers numbers exceeded expectations and we ended up with over 85% of the previous year's numbers. In total, TBSLSC had 649 members in 2020/2021.

The Club's **CORE BUSINESS** of **SURF LIFE SAVING** thrived during the season. Thank you to all our patrolling members for your hard work and dedication in providing 6,977.51 hours volunteering your time to keeping the beach going public safe at Toowoon Bay. In that time, 11 rescues were successfully performed – 9 by IRB and 2 board rescues.

Our Trainers, Assessors and Facilitators managed to deliver COVID safe courses and candidates competently completed these COVID modified courses:

Advanced Resuscitation Techniques (AID):	9 candidates
Bronze Medallion:	25 candidates
Silver Medallion IRB Driver:	1 candidate
Surf Rescue Certificate:	12 candidates

We welcomed the new bronze members to patrols, increasing the strength of our patrolling teams. Credit must go to our Chief Training Officer Sue Hale for all her efforts in her administration and organisation of these COVID safe courses and ensuring the needs of SLSNSW, SLSCC, TAF's and candidates were met. Thanks must also go to our Trainers, Assessors and Facilitators and Special Material Experts and it is with your dedication in delivering outstanding training, assessing and facilitating that TBSLSC continues to produce qualified, confident and adept lifesavers.

The Board decided to recognise three rescues carried out by members, off duty and out of hours. One was by a foundation member of the club who Surf Life Saving was unable to recognise due to him not being a current member of a surf club. Two other rescues were carried out by current members in cold weather, huge seas and in extremely treacherous conditions. These members were awarded Certificates of Recognition from our Federal Member Emma McBride and State Member David Mehan. Details of these rescues are available from the club and all these members are to be commended on their efforts.

Karen Hickmott, our Director of Finance, was very proactive sourcing and securing grants. Among the grants she did secure, one was to construct a purpose-built patrol trailer and Nipper trailer and these both were designed with COVID in mind. We were also able to secure a grant to upgrade the hall. Other successful grants saw the purchase of boards, skis and 3 new defibrillators.

We are thrilled that Karen's commitment to the Club was recognised at the SLSCC Awards of Excellence in June 2021, where she won Administrator of the Year after also being a finalist in the 2020 NSW Rotary Emergency Services Community Awards.

SIPS was able to continue with several COVID 19 interruptions. I thank everyone who volunteered behind the bar and hopefully this will go from strength to strength with the addition of live music once a month.

The Club was unable to hold its major annual fundraisers including the annual Toowoan Bay SLSC Charity Golf Day, Toowoan Bay Ocean Swim and hiring out of the hall was severely curtailed. The Board, with some astute financial management, has however been able to ensure the Club's financial future and has recently created an investment portfolio with the advice of club member and sponsor Stuart Mangion of [Fawkes Financial Services Pty Ltd](#)

TBSLSC must acknowledge our club sponsors and supporters who continue to provide on-going support which allows us to continue to free up funds to purchase quality lifesaving equipment and provide education to our lifesavers and our Nippers – our emerging lifesavers. [Magic Mums Cleaning Central Coast](#) continue to provide a fantastic service in keeping our member's change areas and first aid rooms clean and COVID safe, [Central Coast Council](#) for providing its Beach Safety Operations Fund to all Central Coast Clubs, [Narellan Pools Central Coast](#), [Robbo's Automotive and Tyrepower](#) for continued support. We are very fortunate to have the pro bono support of [Fortunity Chartered Accountants](#), [Fawkes Financial Services Pty Ltd](#), and [Aubrey Brown Lawyers](#). The newest addition to the hall area at TBSLSC is the mural which was provided by [Zest Events International](#). And thanks to [Jeff Hornby of Hornby Project Signage](#) for annually updating our honour boards. Along with the considerable support we receive from OUR incredible sponsors, we must also thank the sponsors of Surf Life Saving Central Coast, Surf Life Saving NSW and Australia. Thanks also to the NSW and Federal Government and NSW Ministry for Police and Emergency Services for their significant support.

Our two nipper programs were a huge success and I thank Lyn Waters (mainstream) and Karen Hickmott (Stingrays – for children with additional needs) for coordinating these. Lyn in particular had no idea at the start of the season how or even if we were going to be able to run a successful nipper program in a global pandemic. The Board decided not to actively promote external competition this year and the programs Lyn has been able to deliver are a credit to her and her team. Stingrays had another great year and all reports from participants and volunteers were extremely positive.

Our Masters competitors were not actively engaged in external competition until late in the season. We did commence the season with a virtual Coolangatta Gold and the club was able to field 8 teams and several individuals comprising of 40 athletes. This was amazing for our club. A group of 15 travelled to SLSNSW Championships at Swansea Belmont in March 2021 and achieved outstanding results. A small team travelled to the QLD Sunshine Coast for the Australian Titles in April 2021 where they achieved an outstanding result - 12th in Australia, 6th in NSW and 1st on the Central Coast. We should all be enormously proud.

The Board has been working on several projects over the last two years and these should come to fruition in the next few months, this will see some positive changes to the club.

The Building Committee suffered a lot of frustrations during the year due to the disruptions at Council, however with Council now stable the Committee is active and sourcing a meeting with the new relevant director to move the renovations/extensions forward. Members will have noticed the remedial works done to the roof, eaves and the repainting that has been carried out on the clubhouse.

Over 160 members of SLS, including TBSLSC members Lyn Waters, Suzanne Gerrish and Ross Blowers, answered the call for assistance with the floods in the Taree area in March 2021, putting themselves in uncomfortable and sometimes hazardous circumstances over a seven-day period. In that time, they helped with everything from doorknocking, delivering fuel and rescuing residents trapped in rising floodwaters. Once again, the local community was overwhelmed by the efforts and thankful that those of us far away were still thinking of them.

I'd like to thank everyone who has organised the wide variety of community-based events that link directly to the Club. This is what makes us different from most other surf clubs.

Our ANZAC Day remembrance morning continues to grow and this year, with no promotion, there were over 200 attendees. Thanks to Mick Cook and his team for organising.

Thank you to the Board - Karen, Lyn, Simon, Mick, and Denise. To our Chief Training Officer Sue and of course our Administration Officer Jacqui. I would also like to thank those senior members who have directly assisted and advised me during the season with their invaluable counsel.

Hopefully, next season will be a more normal season, remember the Club's motto - Join the Fun.

Director of Finance Report - 2020/2021

The detailed financial reports are included in the attached audited financial report however key points to note are:

Overall surplus for the year was \$109,483 up from a deficit of \$21,189 in the previous year.

We were fortunate to receive \$176k in financial support due to COVID-19. This took the form of \$126k in JobKeeper, \$30k in ATO cash flow boosts, \$14k in COVID grants and \$9k from SLSNSW.

In addition, we had a great year in the Café with revenue up nearly \$86k due to much improved weather conditions on the previous year along with increased tourist visitors due to lack of overseas options during the pandemic.

We also received a number of successful insurance claims during the year enabling us to repaint various areas of the club and renew vital rescue equipment.

Sponsorships and grants have also enabled us to further renew equipment and premises and still leave us with a healthy cash balance. Since year end, we have opened a very conservative investment portfolio with the advice and expertise of one of our patrolling members and Club sponsor, Stuart Mangion of [Fawkes Financial Services Pty Ltd](#) to maximize the return we can make on this asset.

One point to note in the financial result however was that during the year following the Council's laying of a permanent beach matting solution at Toowoong Bay we were no longer using the more cumbersome beach matting that we purchased a couple of years ago with grant funding from the Ability Links Beaches for Every Body program and it was taking up valuable space in our overcrowded gear shed. Through our involvement in the Toowoong Bay Stingray Nippers program, we collaborate with other surf lifesaving clubs in NSW providing inclusive practices and we offered the matting to another beach who might be able to use this valuable resource. After the dreadful summer of bushfires on the South Coast we were delighted to be able to donate our now excess matting to Bermagui and Pambula Surf

Life Saving Clubs with the assistance of North Cronulla SLSC for providing the transport. This has been a terrific outcome for the reallocation of scarce resources within the lifesaving movement, but it has resulted in a cost to our profit and loss of just over \$16k this year as we write the asset off out of our books.

Fundraising

Fundraising has been severely hampered by the restrictions imposed by the COVID-19 pandemic and the only fundraising event which has been run during the season was our Sunday Sips which netted \$8,173 – many thanks to the Club members for volunteering their time to make this happen.

Surf Life Saving NSW and the Surf Life Saving Foundation must be acknowledged for conducting fundraising on behalf of Clubs and Branches, and this year we received \$6,100.00 from their efforts. Conducting fundraising efforts centrally frees up our members' time to focus their energy and resources on lifesaving activities – their number one mission. We acknowledge and thank all the members of the general public and donors for their generous support. Thanks for taking the call from Surf Lifesaving and buying raffle tickets. With these funds we purchased vital lifesaving equipment, First Aid Equipment, PPE and training equipment.

Distributions and Donations

We gratefully received the following distributions from events and donors:

Due to the impacts of COVID-19, SLSNSW provided a support package for all clubs. These funds were to be used to directly benefit members and we decided to use our funding to provide a discounted membership to all adult members of the club.

Grants

We were lucky to receive a further \$10,170 from Wyong Rugby Leagues Club Group for the purchase of replacement rescue boards and water safety craft.



We received a \$10,000 COVID-19 small business grant and a \$3,000 COVID-19 recovery grant from the NSW Government which enabled us to cover ongoing business expenses like insurance and additional costs incurred with cleaning and infection control.

\$1,000 Office of Sport COVID-19 Return to Sport Grant secured by SLSNSW enabled us to equip our nipper programme with appropriate equipment to manage the minimization of possible infection.

We were thrilled to receive a grant for \$14,000 from the NSW State Government

Community Building Partnership Program. We were able to put this toward the refurbishment of the hall including painting, remodelling of vestibule, and reprinting, reframing and relocation of life member's photos, installation of the stingray mural on the bar and the 3D logo on the balcony wall. Our thanks to NSW Premier Gladys Berejiklian and Member for The Entrance David Mehan MP for providing this funding.



We completed the development of our replacement patrol trailer from funding received in the previous season as part of the Federal Government's Stronger Communities Program. In fact, we were able to also fund a nipper trailer to assist with the COVID-19 restrictions imposed on us this season from this grant.

During the year we received \$3,000 from our Central Coast Council Community Support Grant application which enabled us to reactivate our rainwater collection tanks.

We also received \$4,000 from the Federal Government's Volunteers Grant Program which enabled us to purchase and install new fans, a fridge and portable speaker for the hall to assist with improving the hall for member functions.

NSW Surf Life Saving Clubs are grateful for the continued support of these Government agencies:

- ✓ NSW Ministry for Police and Emergency Services for the ongoing funding of state-wide operations, which benefit all members through our co-operative agreement.
- ✓ NSW Government for the support through Office of Sport.
- ✓ Federal Government for the Beach Safety Equipment Funding which directs \$5,000.00 to every SLSC for the purchase of vital rescue equipment, PPE, first aid and medical supplies.
- ✓ Federal Government for the VET Funding which enabled hundreds of assessors to update their training qualifications and provided clubs with updated training equipment including QCPR manikins and tablets.

My competition nippers and many others did not return opting to join other clubs.

The biggest concern this season with many new nippers starting at this older age group, was the level of their swimming ability. At least a quarter only just achieved proficiency in the water. To address this, we always provided a modified swim option for those nippers. Only four of my nippers were capable of swimming the course for this age group.

With a smaller group we were able to concentrate on surf/water/board skills more frequently.

At the end of the season, I was very pleased with how proficient the U11's became with their board skills. It was also very satisfying to observe them studying the waves and waiting for the break before rushing in.

We also had some nippers treated for blue bottle stings on one occasion.

Overall, the season was successful, and I look forward to returning in 2021/2022 as the U12's Age Manager.
